	Subject "Approved" Training Classes	Date 12/10/97 SOP# 1002-1

PURPOSE

This intent of this procedure is to ensure that the members of the Manhattan Volunteer Fire Department train together to promote teamwork. This process ensures the interaction of members with one another on a frequent basis to promote trust, brotherhood, and understanding of each other. This procedure shall describe the criteria that a training must meet to be classified as approved to meet the requirement of the continuing training requirement SOP. These requirements shall not limit the inclusion of any documented training from the members permanent training file.

SCOPE

All training classes, seminars, and practical exercises related to the services the Manhattan Fire Protection District provides.

ENFORCEMENT

Training Officer shall be responsible for applying the intent of this procedure.

APPLICATION

Members shall attend a minimum amount of "approved" training to meet the requirements of the Manhattan Fire Protection District.

Training attended by Manhattan personnel that take place on the same day as a scheduled Manhattan training shall be "Approved".

All training attended by Manhattan personnel that take place at Manhattan shall be "Approved".

Training attended by Manhattan personnel that involve team training of which Manhattan is a member shall be "Approved".

Training located at sites other than Manhattan, attended by Manhattan personnel that fulfill the required annual training for Bloodborne Pathogens, CPR, Safe Driving, and SCBA Consumption testing shall be "Approved".

Video training, self study classes and other self instructed training shall be considered for "approval" if the amount of training does not exceed the amount of approved training the member has attended.

Other training may be submitted to the training officer for approval on a case by case basis. Generally the above criteria shall be the accepted criteria.
