## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this procedure is to provide for the highest possible level of safety and health for all members of this organization.

## **SCOPE**

This procedure applies to all members of this organization.

## **ENFORCEMENT**

Primary responsibility for adherence to this procedure rests with each individual. Ultimate responsibility for adherence to this procedure will be set forth through the guidelines described in the standard operating procedures of the Manhattan Fire Protection District.

## **DEFINITION**

This is a policy of the emergency responder Occupational Safety and Health Program of the Manhattan Fire Protection District.

## **APPLICATION**

The prevention and reduction of accidents, injuries, and occupational illnesses are goals of the fire department and shall be primary considerations at all times. This concern for safety and health applies to all members of the fire department and to any other persons who may be involved in fire department activities. This policy should be monitored by the safety officer of the Manhattan Fire Protection District.
